Thereby sticking to proven and provable material and not known closed cases fully investigated resulting in no probable cause and no arrest and no complainant with statute of limitations in effect. It is obvious why the Incident Reports for **SECOND DEGREE HARASSMENT** and **SECOND DEGREE STALKING** (BOTH COURSE OF CONDUCT BEHAVIORS) do not have the Brief Description of **"SUSPICIOUS PERSON"** like the Incident Report for the **SECOND DEGREE BREACH OF PEACE**. Both the Incident Reports (4 Altice Exhibits) that resulted in no arrest after thorough investigation and the March 5, 2018 one-time arrest for **ONE COUNT OF SECOND DEGREE BREACH OF PEACE** were deemed to not have credible evidence aka Probable Cause for any kind of Brief Description of **"HARASSMENT" OR "STALKING"**. After thorough investigations these Incident Reports stand as being without Probable Cause for any type of crime/arrest and thus are unproven and un-provable given the statute of limitations let alone never being re-opened for any reason. If there was any evidence of Course of Conduct behavior or anything related to a **STALKING-LIKE** behavior there would have been an arrest. It is clear that police carefully deploy the **STALKING OR HARASSMENT** language only when there is evidence hence why the officer responsible for the March 5, 2018 arrest (Arrest Warrant) carefully chose his words for the one-time alleged happening now deemed non-criminal after Due Process of Law – **"FOLLOW AND THEN GET RIGHT INTO PERSONAL SPACE"** – a dictionary entry that does not use the words **HARASS** or worse **STALK** – NEVER!

On Thursday, 06/08/2017 at 1207 hours, Officer Lauria, Officer Bergamo and I were dispatched to the parking lot of the Fresh Market, located at 605 Post Road East, after a female employee of the Vincent Palumbo Salon called WPD. The female stated that there was a suspicious male named "James", described as a tall white male wearing a long black trench coat, in the Fresh Market lot who was acting strangely. *False*

I checked the parking lot of the Fresh Market, but met with negative results. I responded to the Palumbo Salon, where I met with the caller, later identified as Blair Rencurrel, who stated that "James" has been hanging out in the Fresh Market lot and making the employees of the salon uncomfortable. Rencurrel stated that "James" knows that the salon employees park across the street in the Fresh Market lot, and that he has approached workers in the past.

I met with Olivia Farb, who stated that she was the employee that was approached by "James" today. Farb stated that she had gone across the street to the Fresh Market, and that she was sitting in her vehicle. Farb stated that "James" pulled into the parking spot next to her and began a conversation about the "crazy matrix". Farb stated that she was uncomfortable but she continued the conversation with "James". Farb stated that towards the end of the conversation, "James" asked her out for coffee. Farb stated that she ignored "James", and that she said she had to go. Farb stated that she did not want to have any further contact with "James", and that he should be told not to approach her or have any contact in the future. *LCR*

Rencurrel stated that "James" drove a silver BMW a few years old, and I immediately suspected that the male named "James" was James Lawrence, whom I have had dealing with before. Lawrence had previously been advised to stay away from another female he encountered at the Fresh Market (refer to file #2016-022538). Lawrence is a tall white male, and drives a silver BMW.

I advised Farb that I would attempt to speak with Lawrence to determine if he was in fact the person who spoke to her, and if so, to avoid any further contact. Officer Lauria, Officer Bergamo and I responded to 75 West Parish Road to speak with Lawrence, but no one was home.

I called a telephone number for Lawrence, obtained from the CAD RMS system, and left a message for Lawrence to contact me.

On Friday, 06/09/2017 at 0744 hours, I telephoned Lawrence after he left a voice mail. Lawrence was advised of the complaint that had been made, and he admitted that he was in fact the person who had approached Farb. Lawrence stated that he had gone to the Fresh Market, and that he had struck up a conversation with Farb. Lawrence claimed that he had no idea that Farb worked at the salon, and stated that the employees of the salon have been "bad mouthing" him. Lawrence stated that Rachel Terzer was a client of the Palumbo salon, and that the employee of the salon were aware of the complaint that Terzer had made against him (refer to file #2016-022538). *Yes*

Lawrence was advised that Farb did not want any further contact with him, and Lawrence stated that he understood. Lawrence stated that he wanted the employees of the salon to stop talking about him, but that he wanted nothing to do with anyone who worked there. The conversation was recorded on my VieVu body camera.

I telephoned the salon and spoke with Rencurrel, as Farb was not in yet, and advised Rencurrel that Lawrence had advised not to have any further contact with Farb. Rencurrel stated that she would pass the message along to Farb.

I was dispatched to Barnes and Noble bookstore on an unwanted person. Upon arrival I spoke to the manager Philip Marcus. Marcus explained to me on March 29, 2004 two customers, Jim Lawrence and another person, got into an argument inside the store. The argument got heated to the point where both wanted to go outside to settle the problem in a fight. Marcus told me he was not working that night but the assistant manager Noreen Galvin called the police (2004-004485).

Marcus then explained to me on April 5 2004 Jim Lawrence returned to the store after being told not to by Galvin on March 29th. When Marcus confronted Lawrence he told him the store was serious about not wanting him back in the store and to leave. Marcus told me Lawrence used profanities, creating a scene, and disturbed other customers in the store with his yelling. Marcus added he did not call the police but told Lawrence he would if he did not leave.

Tonight Marcus said he called the police because he saw Lawrence driving around the parking lot in his Mercedes about an hour ago. Marcus also said he called because Lawrence has been calling the store repeatedly, and calling the district manager repeatedly.

Marcus told me Lawrence has been warned by him and is not allowed back in the store. I told Marcus I would talk to Lawrence and explain to him the store's request. I also told Marcus if Lawrence returns to call the police and not to confront him. Marcus agreed and was given an incident card. Marcus added he did not want to pursue criminal charges now but next he will.

Officer Hayes and I went to 238 Greens Farms Road to speak with Jim Lawrence. Lawrence told us Barnes and Noble was violating his civil rights by not allowing him into the store. Lawrence added he was getting an attorney to "fight" the problem.

I told Lawrence he is not allowed to enter the Barnes and Noble bookstore anymore. I told him the management does not want him in the store, and if he was to return in the future he will be arrested. Lawrence told me that was not fair but would let his lawyer handle it. Lawrence assured Officer Hayes and I he would not go in the store.

06/03/04. On this date this officer received a telephone call from Mr. James Lawrence requesting to come to headquarters to speak to this officer about the problems he has been experiencing at the Barnes and Noble store. He stated that this officer has spoken to him in the past about these incidents and arrangements were made for Mr. Lawrence to come to headquarters to speak to this officer about this incident. Mr. Lawrence arrived at headquarters and was taken into the youth bureau office where he advised that he had just come from meeting with Peter Blount, the regional director of the Barnes and Noble stores and he gave this officer a copy of a letter which he had given to Mr. Blount expressing his concerns and displeasures with the way he perceives that he was being treated by store personnel.

letter to store

In speaking with Mr. Lawrence he felt that he was being unfairly accused of being involved in various incidents within the Barnes and Noble store which ultimately led to his being asked by the store management to leave this location and that he was now not welcome there in the future as a customer. This officer reminded Mr. Lawrence that this officer is aware of four (4) incidents that have taken place at the Barnes and Noble store where his conduct has been reported to be offensive by the complainants in his approach to female patrons of the store. (Cross reference to incident report numbers: #03-6735, #03-18610, #04-4485 and #04-5428).

Mr. Lawrence asked this officer to speak to the management of Barnes and Noble to finally determine what the reasons are for his not being allowed into the store. It should be noted that Mr. Lawrence has been told by store personnel, Philip Marcus and Noreen Galvin on two separate occasions that he is not welcome at this store and not to return there as he is causing problems with his behavior. Also officer Arnette and officer Hayes went to the Lawrence residence (#238 Greensfarms Road) on 04/08/04 (#04-5428) and was told that the management does not want him in the store and he was advised by both officers that if he returned in the future he would be arrested. This officer advised Mr. Lawrence that this officer would speak to the management for a clarification of their position.

06/03/04: This officer contacted the Barnes and Noble store and spoke to Noreen Galvin and she stated that she would contact her supervisor, Patricia Burgess and attempt to schedule a date and time to meet with this officer to discuss the problem with Mr. Lawrence from their perspective. Ms. Galvin called this officer back and an appointment was scheduled for 06/04/04 at 1300 hours at the store itself.

06/04/04: This officer arrived at the Barnes and Noble store as scheduled and met with both Patricia Burgess and Noreen Galvin and during this interview they disclosed that they both have had problems in dealing with Mr. Lawrence's behavior within the store. Mrs. Burgess stated that she has spoken to Mr. Lawrence of the telephone about his behavior and that he was belligerent towards her in the way he was speaking to her and that he was using profanity during his conversation with her.

B.S.

Both Ms. Galvin and Mrs. Burgess stated that they have received numerous verbal complaints from female shoppers in the store that have complained to them about feeling uncomfortable about the way Mr. Lawrence made them feel when he was blatantly staring at them while he was sitting with his friends in the cafe area of the store. They both stated that in most cases they did not report these incidents to the police department because they felt that there was nothing that could be done about these situations. Mrs. Burgess also stated that Mr. Lawrence had gone over to the regional manager's office on 06/03/04 (Peter Blount) and had given him a letter and that Mr. Lawrence had apparently been argumentative with Mr. Blount and had referred to him as a "weenie" as he was leaving the office.

It should be noted that when this officer met with Mr. Lawrence on 06/03/04 he showed this officer the letter he had given to Mr. Blount and this officer made a copy of the letter for this incident file. In speaking with Ms. Galvin and Mrs. Burgess this officer was given two (2) copies of letters one from Colleen Carroll and one from Sarah Milici both former employees of the Westport Barnes and Noble store. Ms. Carroll's letter addresses the fact that when she was outside in front of the store she found Mr. Lawrence yelling and physically assaulting a regular customer named "Alan". The letter continues to state that Mr. Lawrence was throwing "Alan" up against the front plate glass window and repeatedly verbally threatening Alan. Ms. Carroll's letter further states that she yelled over Mr. Lawrence to stop his behavior or she would contact the police department. At this point Mr. Lawrence stepped away from "Alan" and apparently left the property. The police department was never contacted to investigate this incident. This officer asked both Ms. Galvin and Mrs. Burgess if they could identify "Alan" further and they stated that they didn't know his last name but that he was fearful of retaliation from Mr. Lawrence if he did speak to the police about this incident.

The second letter from Sarah Milici addressed the fact that a group of three individuals would come into the store and sit in the cafe area and would just "leer" at the young female patrons who were shopping at the store at the time. She stated that this group, which according to Ms. Galvin and Mrs. Burgess contains Mr. Lawrence would on a nightly basis make the staff wait until after closing time to put the books that they were reading at the time. Ms. Milici's letter continues to state that these three individuals would insist in putting their reading materials away which ultimately made the entire staff wait until these three people left the store before starting the closing procedures.

Ms. Milici also stated in her letter that these three people as a group became aggressive towards an elderly gentlemen that had apparently come to Ms Milici's assistance when she spoke to the group about their behavior. It should be noted that this officer was told by Ms Galvin and Mrs. Burgess that Mr. Lawrence wasn't the person who was had argued with the elderly gentlemen but that he was with the group and did nothing to stop the confrontation. Ms Milici continued to state that the manager on duty told the group that they were no longer welcome in the store and felt that these three patrons (believed to be James Lawrence, Walter Reddy and Lucas Stone) are aggressive towards customers and their conduct is inappropriate making the atmosphere inside of Barnes and Noble unsafe for customers and booksellers alike.

It should also be noted that when this officer met with Mr. Lawrence on 06/03/04 he gave this officer three (3) letters which attested to his character and they were from Luke Stone, Walter Reddy and Anne Roberts.

In summary after meeting with both Ms Galvin and Mrs. Burgess it appears that Mr. Lawrence's conduct has made various female customers concerned enough about his behavior towards them that they have either reported these incidents to the Barnes and Noble staff or have made complaints with the police department itself. Mrs. Burgess as the store manager requested that Mr. Lawrence be told once and for all that he is not allowed in the store in the future due to all of the problems that he has caused in the past year or so.

It should be noted that when this officer was speaking to Mr. Lawrence he advised that he again was leaving for Europe on 06/06/04 and would in all likely hood be out of Westport for the summer months. He advised that this officer could e-mail him with the Barnes and Noble stores decision as to whether he was welcome there as a customer or not. Mr. Lawrence's e-mail address is sancorgoman@hotmail.com. This officer did not e-mail Mr. Lawrence with this officer's findings concerning this investigation as he had been informed by this officer prior to his going to Europe that the management of the store simply did not want him to return to the store as a customer or wanted his business as he has been disruptive in the store on previous occasions and they do not want him to return there for any reason.

He was reminded that enforcement action will be taken against him should he not take heed of this warning. The call ended abruptly as Lawrence attempted to offer rationalizations for his behavior.
