Hello Mr. Lawrence,

All of this department's Facebook postings regarding arrests are deleted after approximately thirty days.

The Facebook posting however is a mirror image of the information that must be disseminated at the time of a custodial arrest to be in compliance with the release of arrestee information, case information and associated charges as is statutorily required by public records law.

In that particular case, I did look up the press release information and found that the following was the narrative associated with that arrest:

"On 11/05/2017, officers were dispatched to a local grocery store on a report of a suspicious person. The victim reported she was followed around the store by an unknown male who then followed her out to her car and stood by the door of her vehicle. The male was later identified as James Lawrence, 52, of Westport, CT. An arrest warrant application was submitted for approval and granted by a judge. On 03/05/2018, Lawrence turned himself on the active arrest warrant. He was charged with 53a-181 Breach of Peace and released after posting \$5,000 court set bond. Lawrence is scheduled to appear in Norwalk Court on 3/14/18."

That you for all your help while I was briefly back in the area.  
I have legal issues to pursue here for the coming year in regards to News 12, the Westport News, and Miss Wendy Chambers.  
Attached is an Email from you in regards to questions I had about an arrest warrant that was rejected by the District Attorney that seems to clarify your policy on what and how you redact material from release.  
I recently had a good experience with 2 journalists reporting on my ongoing case against News 12 where they originally parroted the controversial material the Westport News questionably writes about.  
The good experience is that after a proper dialogue as to the issues at hand in my cases against News 12 and Westport News these other two journalists rewrote their articles in proper ways that seem to be in tune with your "matters of practice to redact from release criminal history information".

The strange thing is Officer, I have no criminal history in Ct. as written Officer Sullivan's Arrest Warrant for the March 5, 2018 arrest for one count of second degree breach of peace, and I am certain I only have one conviction on my record and that is a felony Domestic Violence conviction in California from 1996. All else mentioned in Arrest Warrants by Officer Sullivan and then Officer Grasso are either mentioning an arrest that NEVER became a charge - 2013 domestic battery dispute in California, or charges that NEVER became a conviction - 1995 stalking charge. There is a 1987 evading police charge in Florida that to the best of my knowledge was plead down to an infraction of Nolle, and a 1994 petty theft in California that was also plead to infraction or Nolle Prosequi.  
**I appreciate a proper understanding of my arrest record in tune with the words in the attached email.  
I also appreciate any other proper redactions in regards to any other questionable unproven and un-provable material.**
