On 09/18/2018, the victim responded to police headquarters and reported ongoing harassment by James Lawrence of Westport, CT. The victim stated multiple requests were made to Lawrence to stop contacting her however, he continued to do so by email. The investigating officer submitted an arrest warrant application, which was later approved.

On 02/06/2019, an officer observed Lawrence at a local gas station. The officer confirmed Lawrence had an outstanding warrant and took him into custody. Lawrence was brought to police headquarters where he was charged with 53a-183 Harassment 2nd and released after posting \$25,000 court set bond. Lawrence was scheduled to appear in Norwalk Court on 02/07/2019.

Affidavit

The undersigned affiant, being duly sworn, deposes and says:

1. That the affiant, Officer Mark D. Grasso #4841 is a sworn member of the Westport, CT Police Department and has been a member of said department since February 26, 2018. The affiant previously served as a sworn member of the Connecticut State Police for 20 years and 6 months. The affiant has received advanced training in criminal and motor vehicle investigations and conducted numerous investigations in these areas. At all times mentioned herein, this affiant was acting in his official capacity as a member of said department. This affiant has personal knowledge of the facts stated herein through his own investigative efforts and the efforts of fellow officers who have reported the results of their investigation(s) to this affiant.

2. That per section 46b-38b of the Connecticut General Statutes, the victim's name, address and other identifying information will not be disclosed. The 54 year old female victim will hereinafter be referred to as "V-1" or "Victim 1".

3. That on 09/17/2018, I was assigned to respond to V-1's address to meet with the tenant, who wanted to report a concern. She reported that she was made aware that the accused, James J. Lawrence date of birth 12/15/1965, who was arrested by Officer Sullivan of the Westport Police Department in March 2018, had returned to Westport from Europe yesterday for a court appearance in Norwalk today. According to V-1, she leased the apartment from the accused's parents and the accused is not listed as a lessor on the rental agreement. V-1 has a month to month lease which officially ends on 12/01/2018 and she plans to vacate the apartment. V-1 stated that is very much aware of the accused's proclivity for stalking and harassing women and is concerned for her safety and the safety of the other women at that address because the accused has access to the keys to all of the apartments at that address and has previously entered the dwelling on several occasions. She reported that on one occasion, the accused waited in the dark in the basement where the washing machine and dryer are located. She stated that when another female tenant went down to the basement to do laundry, the accused approached her from behind, placed his hand over her mouth and said something to her. According to V-1, that other tenant will not do laundry at home anymore.

Perjury!!!

4. That while at V-1's apartment, I noticed that there were paper towels taped to the windows. When I asked, V-1 stated that she taped the paper towels there to prevent the accused from looking into her apartment. That V-1 also stated that she had changed the locks on the door to her apartment in fear that the accused would use his keys to gain access to her apartment either to do harm to her while she was there or to enter the apartment while she

5. That V-1 and I knocked on the door to the other first floor apartment where the other female tenant resides. There was a long delay before the tenant answered the door. I announced that I was from the police department and then the door was opened. V-1 explained to the tenant that she had contacted the police regarding the accused. My interaction with her was brief. Based on my training and experience, it appeared to me that she was uncomfortable with my presence. I did note that her windows appeared to have a dark colored glazing on them.

6. That the affiant has attempted to interview the other female tenant and obtain a written statement from her, but she is unwilling to provide a written statement.

7. That V-1 and I walked around to the side of the house where the basement hatchway doors were located. I found them to be unlocked. V-1 stated that they are always left unlocked so that anyone can gain free access to the basement where the laundry area is located. There is a stairway that leads to the first floor apartment where V-1 resides. V-1 stated that she did not know that the basement hatchway doors could be locked, so I showed her the latching mechanism and locked the door for her.

8. That on 09/17/2018, V-1 stated that she did not want to file a formal complaint but only wanted her concerns documented in the event that something was to happen to her.

9. That on On 09/18/2018, V-1 forwarded an email chain of communication between her and the accused. V-1 indicates that this communication was directly as a result of basement doors at the home being locked. The message from the accused from the email address jameslarenaissance@gmail.com states, "Anna Advice - do not cause my beloved 77 year old parents any stress whatsoever. Take this advice." The complainant replied to this communication stating, "What was not Crystal Clear to you in me writing ""do not contact me again"" FOR ANY REASON? KEEP THIS UP AND I WILL CONTACT THE POLICE. LEAVE ME ALONE!!!!!"

The email in question

Lies only email submitted

10. That I contacted V-1 by phone to discuss this email thread with her. She stated that there was more to the story that she did not want to initially share with me the night before because her friend, Marie Pelletier, who previously resided in a second floor apartment at the same address, was in the room at that time and she was embarrassed to share certain details with Marie there. V-1 stated that she had been involved in a brief dating relationship with the accused. She stated the relationship began sometime around June or July of 2018, almost immediately after she met the accused after he advertised his apartment for rent on Craigslist. She stated during that initial meeting, the accused asked her out for coffee and they began seeing each other.

LIAR

11. That V-1 stated that she and the accused have communicated by phone, text, and email. She stated that one evening, she and the accused went out for dinner/drinks to the Pearl Restaurant at Longshore in Westport. That evening, she and the accused had unprotected sexual intercourse at his apartment. She stated that that occurred on July 15, 2018. She stated that that evening, the accused told her that he was "a player" and his demeanor toward her changed after they had sex. V-1 stated that it was almost as though "the chase" was over and the accused was no longer interested in her.

Jealous, scorned woman

12. That On 09/22/2018 at approximately 0810 hours, I met with V-1 at Westport Police Headquarters in the Detective Bureau interview room. We began to discuss her complaint. She became very concerned that her name would somehow be released subsequent to a freedom of information request or to members of the media. I explained that the police department could only redact certain information and that there was a possibility that

she may be called to testify in regard to her complaint. I explained that in my opinion, based on the fact that she was in a brief dating relationship with the accused, that this now met the statutory definition of domestic violence and therefore, she would not be identified by name in the police reports. The interview was stopped and we discussed her concerns. LT. Prezioso joined the discussion and reiterated the information that I had conveyed to the victim. V-1 explained that she was extremely tired because she hadn't slept in several days due to her fear that James Lawrence may use the keys that he has access to gain entry into her apartment. She stated that she couldn't think clearly and needed to give additional thought to whether she wanted to make this formal complaint. I provided her with Victim's Rights cards and asked if there was someplace that she could go, where she felt safe, to get some rest. She explained that she had a friend whose house she could go to and take a nap.

13. That a short time later, V-1 contacted me by phone at police headquarters and stated that when she returned to her apartment, she spoke with the other tenants there and she realized that she needed to make this complaint not only for her protection but to protect other women who have been victimized by the accused. The victim stated that she would return to police headquarters on Tuesday, September 25th to provide her written statement.

14. That on 09/25/2018 between approximately 1000 hours and 1200 hours, V-1 provided a four-page, sworn, written statement detailing her relationship with the accused, James Lawrence, and her complaint of his harassment of her through text and email communication. She stated, "I was involved in a brief dating relationship with James Lawrence that began sometime around June or July of 2018, almost immediately after I met James when he advertised his apartment, where I now reside, for rent on Craigslist. At that time, I was residing in Wilton and wanted to shorten my commute into Manhattan. When I came to look at the apartment, James met me there. He is an attractive man, who came across as very charming. After looking at the apartment, I knew that I wanted to rent it and told James that I would take it. We agreed that I would move in on 07/28/2018. During that initial meeting, James asked me out for coffee and we began seeing each other. When I asked James why he was leaving the apartment, he told me that he was going to Europe for three months because he had to get away from Westport because the Police and FBI were after him. He said it was no longer safe for him to live in Westport. I'm pretty sure that he told me that he had been wrongly arrested and that he was suing Channel 12."

Lies - emails shows she knew

The victim went on to explain how she learned about the accused's arrest when she moved into his apartment as he vacated it to go to Europe. She explained that she remained in contact with him to "keep tabs" on him so that she knew when he would be returning. She stated, "On August 21, 2018, I found out that James was coming home to Westport, CT for a court date. He emailed me to tell me that. On that date, I told him that I was moving to West Virginia and offered to help him find a new tenant for the apartment so as to make the transition non-confrontational. I wasn't really moving, but had to give 30 days' notice to break the lease. Again, I wanted him to think I was a friend so that he wouldn't harass or hurt me. However, I also felt it was imperative to let him know that this was my apartment now and that he was not welcome there while I was still living there. He was not to terrorize my cats. I told him this because he thinks it's funny to terrorize my cats. I told him that I have a lease with his parents and that if they need access to my apartment, that I would need 24-hours' notice as per the terms of my lease. I asked him in that email, "Is that clear?" and he responded, "Crystal."

On September 5, 2018, I emailed James and stated, "And while you are in town - I don't want you to upset my cats by dropping by for any reason. They are my family and I am their Stewart and it's not a joke. All of your things (except the couch which is covered and the king mattress) are packed away in the basement or at your

I need no additional stress in my life while you are in town. Please respect my privacy and the terms of the lease, that is alli ask. I don't want any problems. Thanks for respecting this email. No bad vibe intended, I just want peace and quiet in my life while in CT. Sure you do too. All units rented so I am sure your parents want no problems either. Thanks and safe travels back."

fabricated doctored email

The victim stated, "On or about 09/15/2018, James and I exchanged emails again. This time I wrote to him, "'Fine. Don't contact me again or come by the apartment while I am here. I leave on Sept 30. I never want to see you again. Understand? Clear???" James responded, "'CRYSTAL ... THIS COULD HVE WAITED.AND YOU COULD HAVE INFORMED ME OF THE FUCKING "POLICEMAN" WHEN IT HAPPENED. I DO NOT KNOW WHAT TO BELIEVE WITH YOU.'" I had told him that what I thought was an unmarked police car arrived at the apartment and a man in plain clothes was asking about him. I was trying to keep him away from me and the apartment until I could move out. I again responded, "'Stop!'"

Perjury

She stated, "I have taken steps to attempt to make myself feel more safe in my apartment including hanging paper towels on the sidelights of the bay window to prevent anyone from seeing inside, and locking my windows and doors. I was very concerned because of the free access that anyone, including James, has to the basement through the "'Bilco'" hatchway doors. I did not know that they could be locked until Officer Grasso assisted me with engaging the latch to secure the access to the basement on 09/17/2018."

living in my apartment holds belongings hostage

V-1 stated, "On 09/18/2018, I received a text message from Mrs. Lawrence, James's mother, asking about the locked basement hatchway. I can only assume that James came by and found it locked and reported this to his mother. I replied to her in an email that stated in part, "'...I am again writing, I want nothing to do with him and maybe now you both. I will clean the apt and leave the keys on the kitchen counter, text you the evening of the 30th that I am gone. I want nothing to do with whatever comes of him, for he's not going to stop harassing women and/or writing his rants. Just leave me be as I just want the peace I deserve while renting these last few weeks. I wish you both peace as well, for I guess you won't get it until you are both back in FL...'"

Shortly after sending that email, I received an email from James that said, "'(V-1) Advice - do not cause my beloved 77 year old parents any stress whatsoever. Take this advice.'" I take this as a threat. After repeated requests for him to stop contacting me, he continues to email me something like this. Considering James's past and my belief that he is mentally unstable, I am in fear for my safety and want him arrested."

15. That V-1 provided me with copies of the email communications between her and the accused. Her final communication to him on 09/22/2018 at 6:03 AM states, "WHAT PART OF CRYSTAL CLEAR ARE YOU MISSING? THIS WILL BE THE 3RD TIME I HAVE WRITTEN YOU TO NOT CONTACT ME. YOU HAVE THREATENED ME, NOW CONTACTED ME AGAIN. STRIKE 3. THIS IS HARASSMENT AND I AM DONE. DO NOT CONTACT ME AGAIN FOR ANY ANY ANY REASON WHATSOEVER! I AM TERRIFIED OF you AND HAVE ASKED, TOLD AND BEGGED YOUR PARENTS TO KEEP YOU UNDER CONTROL. WHEN I LEAVE ON THE NIGHT OF THE 30TH, YOUR PARENTS, WHO OWN THIS HOUSE, CAN DO AS THEY WILL. LEAVE ME ALONE!!!!!!!!!"

Liar feigns

16. That I have made multiple attempts to obtain a statement from the "other tenant" whom I briefly met with on 09/17/2018 at V-1's address. To date, she has not come forward to do so. However, on 09/26/2018 at approximately 1355 hours, I made contact with her by phone. During my conversation with her, she stated that

she is concerned for her safety. She stated that she lives by herself and that the accused is "creepy". When I asked about the glazing on the windows in her apartment, I asked her if she did that to prevent the accused from seeing inside. She responded, "It's to prevent anyone from seeing in." I asked her if she would have done that if the accused wasn't around and she stated, "No." She stated that there are times that she would be in the basement doing laundry and the accused would pull up and sit in his car. She stated she would stay in the basement as long as I could "hoping he would leave," but he would stay there until she walked out of the basement. She stated that he had to know that it was her in the basement, because at that time only she and the accused lived at the house and the basement hatchway doors were generally only left in the open position when someone was down there doing laundry. She stated that when she would go out to the mailbox, the accused would "always come out and watch me." She stated, "His presence makes me feel uncomfortable. I don't engage him. I avoid him at all costs. I don't give him a chance to get aggressive."

17. That on 09/27/2018, I obtained a written statement from [redacted] in which she details a stalking complaint against James Lawrence. This complaint is being investigated under Westport Police Department case number 2018-020668.

18. That in his arrest warrant affidavit dated 12/23/2017, Westport Police Officer James Sullivan noted, "That in checking this department's case history with Lawrence, I learned that there were 10 case incidents logged from 2002 till present. In all of these complaints Lawrence was seen following the complainants around a store or coffee shop and then following them out to their cars where he would either stare at them or get right into their personal space. In most of these cases, Lawrence was told that his actions scared the complainants to the point of them calling the police. He has even stated himself that he needed to rethink his approach with woman. That I also learned from these reports that there were a lot of other incidents with Lawrence that were not reported to the police."

insane lies

19. That in his arrest warrant affidavit dated 12/23/2017, Westport Police Officer James Sullivan noted, "That in this case (2017-022937), the complainant would not provide a sworn statement for fear that Lawrence would be able to find out who she was and then be able to retaliate against her. I also learned that in all the 9 other cases that the complainants all felt the same way. That they all feared for their safety and because of this were reluctant to provide statements."

Police look to NOT make same mistake

20. That I conducted a criminal history check for the accused which revealed his arrest by Officer Sullivan on 03/05/2018 for Breach of Peace. In addition, the accused has an arrest record in the state of Florida dating back to 1986 and in California dating back to 1994. Prior to his arrest by Officer Sullivan, the accused was most recently arrested on 10/31/2013 for "BAT: SPOUSE/EX SP/DATE/ETC".

21. That based upon the facts of my investigation combined with the details of Officer Sullivan's investigation, I can say that based on my training and experience that the accused is continuing his criminal activity and predatory behavior toward women. That based on the aforementioned facts and circumstances, I have probable cause to believe and request that an arrest warrant be issued for James J. Lawrence, date of birth 12/15/1965 of LKA: 3 Lookout Trail, Westport, CT for the crime of Harassment in the Second Degree (Sec. 53a-183 of the C. G.S.) for communicating with V-1 by email with the intent and manner to cause her annoyance or alarm.
